## CAMS for Post-operative Pain and Inflammation



Nicole Beggs is a retired registered nurse who has had over twenty surgeries during her lifetime. She understands

post-operative pain and inflammation from a personal as well as a professional perspective.

In 2011 Nicole had bunion surgery with insertion of a metal pin in her right big toe. It took two months and a fair amount of pain medication before healing was complete.

In 2012, Nicole was introduced to the CAMS technology. She used it to help to control the side effects of chemotherapy. "It opened my eyes to energy healing and since that time I have discovered its usefulness for a variety of ailments - particularly post-operative pain and healing," reports, Nicole.

"In May of 2012, I had a debridement of my left big toe joint for arthritis. After the first few days of pain and inflammation, I decided to try the PulseCam. Twenty-four hours later I no longer required any pain medication."

The following year, Nicole had a second bunion surgery on the right large toe - again with pin insertion. After an uncomfortable first day, she decided to experiment with the PulseCam.

Within 24 hours, she was pain-free and stopped taking all pain medication. Nicole continued to use the PulseCam twice a day and to everyone's surprise, the pin was removed three weeks early. It was a completely different experience from the first bunion surgery.

Later the same year (2013), Nicole needed arthroscopic surgery on both knees for meniscus tears. "This time I began using the PulseCam twice a day on the day of surgery. I was astonished. I had *no pain* and little swelling. In October of the same year, I used the PulseCam for four dental implants - again, there was no pain."

"I began to see a very important, repeatable pattern," remembers Nicole. "So, in April of this year [2014] when I had the joint of my left big toe replaced (with a titanium spacer, bone filing, and release of an impinged ligament) I was ready with both the PulseCam and the camera." The above photo is just two weeks after reconstructive surgery." CAMS technology has proven to be an amazing tool for post-operative pain and healing. I'm glad I discovered it when I did," smiles Nicole.

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
