CAMS - A Revolutionary Treatment for Angina



Angina is a clinical syndrome characterized by pain, and/or a feeling of tightness in the chest. It is caused by decreased coronary blood flow and an

inadequate supply of oxygen to the heart. Angina is usually associated with atherosclerotic heart disease and accompanying obstruction of a major coronary artery. Factors that may induce an attack are: physical exertion, exposure to cold, a heavy meal, stress, or any emotion-provoking situation that increases blood pressure, heart rate, and myocardial workload.

In the following account, a 58-year-old female medical doctor from Zurich, Switzerland, describes her symptoms as those of Prinzmetal's angina--spasms in the arteries--brought on by emotional stress. TensCam treatment alleviated her symptoms and brought relief after many days of pain.

Following eight weeks of emotional stress, accompanied by muscular tension, insomnia and lack of appetite, I began experiencing Prinzmetal's angina. Intense cramping pain spanned my whole chest area, more on the left side. Over the next few days, I was easily exhausted and experienced difficulty breathing. EKG showed low s-t-curve, (signs of ischemia, but no damage of the heart muscle).

Enzymes were normal. Then came four days of intense localized heart pain (15 minutes at a time) on the left side with difficulty breathing. I could only lie on my knees bent over to the right side. A 5-minute TensCam treatment relieved all pain. The EKG was almost normal and x-rays of the lungs were also normal. Three further TensCam treatments successfully treated remaining breathing difficulties and anxiety. Now, 14 days later, I am back to normal.
